



The Conference exhibitions will be held in the Hawkes Bay Exhibition Centre, 201 Eastbourne Street, Hastings 4122. Opening times are from 10.00am to 4.30pm daily.

There will be an Official Opening function on Friday 11 July at the Exhibition Centre and the exhibitions will be open to the public from Saturday 12 July to 16 August.

Awards will be presented at the Conference Dinner on the evening of 12 July.

conditions of entry

- All entries must be the entrant's own work and completed within two years prior to June 2008.
- **Entries must not have been previously exhibited at a national or international exhibition.**
- All entries will be subject to selection except those for the Young Persons' exhibition. The Selectors' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the selection of entries.
- All entries must have a major stitched content, whether by hand or machine.
- All entries intending to be hung must have secure means of hanging.
- Insurance of entries in transit and during the exhibition is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor. All reasonable care will be taken
- Work may be for sale – a gallery commission will apply.

ENTRY FORMS

- Please send Section A of your entry form and entry fee to the Exhibitions Convenor, PO Box 7193, Taradale 4141 to arrive no later than 6 June 2008. No entry forms will be accepted after the closing date.
- Up to three works per person per exhibition may be entered, each with a separate entry form – please photocopy as required.
- One stamped self addressed envelope per entrant, plus completed Acceptance Advice Form must accompany submissions for all exhibitions.
- We suggest that each completed entry form is photocopied for your reference.

ENTRY FEES

- The entry fee is \$20 for each work submitted, except for the Young Persons' Exhibition where the entry fee is \$5 for each work submitted. Please make cheques payable to Conference 2008.

PACKAGING

- Each entry must be clearly labelled with your name, the title of the work, the exhibition title and the price you require (if applicable). These details must be on a swing tag attached to the back of the work. Do not use sticky labels.

- Although the entries of more than one exhibitor may be sent in one package, each entry must be well packaged in its own separate named cloth bag. Flat articles may be wrapped around a padded cardboard tube before being placed in a small cloth bag. It is important to use strong, secure and reusable packaging with a minimum of parcel tape. Please name all packaging. Any entry received in unsatisfactory packaging will be rejected, unopened and returned immediately.

DELIVERY/RETURNING

- The dates for receiving the work are between 20 June and 26 June. The deadline for receiving work for selection is 4pm on 26 June 2008.
- All entries must be addressed to Conference 2008 and posted or delivered to The Hawke's Bay Exhibition Centre, 201 Eastbourne Street East, Hastings 4122.
- Exhibitors will pay all delivery costs, including return delivery. **Posted entries will be accepted but must meet the above deadlines for delivery.**

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that this deadline is met. Late entries will not be accepted and will be returned immediately.

- Please place Section B of your entry form together with return prepaid courier vouchers/postage and return address labels in an envelope attached securely to the outside of the package.
- Non selected work will be returned after selection (except those in multiple consignment containers where all items will be returned after the exhibition).
- All accepted work will be released for return at the end of the exhibition on 16 August.
- Any sold exhibits will be released to the purchaser at the close of the exhibitions.

PHOTOGRAPHY

- **No cameras are allowed in the exhibition areas.** Photographs of all accepted work will be available for ordering, prepaid at the Registration Office, Lindisfarne College.
- Conference 2008 and the Association of New Zealand Embroiderers' Guilds reserve the right to use photographs and copy related to all entries for publicity purposes.

OPEN EXHIBITION: Selected

All Things Bright and Beautiful

Open to all embroiderers, artists or craftpersons. Work must be original in concept and design. Multi-media entries with major stitch content would be considered. Presentation of work must be an integral part of total work. Entries must not have been exhibited previously at a national or international exhibition. Work must have been produced within the last two years.

OPEN MINIATURE EXHIBITION: Selected

Behold the Amazing Gift

Open to all embroiderers, artists or craft persons. The work area of each item must not exceed 15cm x 15cm, excluding the mount or frame. The work area is not to extend beyond the dimensions stated. Multi-media entries with a major stitch content would be considered. Presentation of work must be the integral part of the total work. Entries must not have been exhibited previously at a national or international exhibition. The definition of miniature for this exhibition is 'a smaller version of the original'.

MEMBERS ONLY EXHIBITION: Selected

Glorious Things

Entries to be the work of a member of a Guild affiliated to ANZEG. Refer to General Conditions. No kits, charts or workshop designs accepted. Work may be traditional, creative or lace and must reflect the individuality of the maker.

YOUNG PERSONS: Non-Selected

Joy to the World

Any young person under 18 years of age at 30 June 2008 may submit work for this exhibition. Entries to be no larger than 60cm square and must be able to be hung. The definition of embroidery for this exhibition is hand or machine stitching with fabric and thread.

EXTENSIONS: Non-Selected

Art Deco Personal Adornment

General conditions of entry apply. ANZEG Extensions reserve the right to withdraw work that is not up to standard.
