## delegates, non-voting delegates, observers – BGM

For the Biennial General Meeting, Guilds are invited to elect representatives to vote on their behalf.

A **delegate** is your Guild representative at the Biennial General Meeting. Delegates sit in a specially designated area and if an issue is voted on, your delegate has the right to cast a vote on your Guild's behalf.

A **non-voting delegate** sits with the delegate and assists in decision-making on behalf of your Guild. She does not have voting rights.

An **observer** is any Guild member who wishes to attend the Biennial General meeting. All Guild members are most welcome to attend this meeting and are encouraged to do so. Observers generally do not sit with the delegates but in the main body of the meeting venue.
